

## **HEALTH AND SAFETY INFORMATION VICTORIAN DAY**

To avoid the misuse of the tools and materials on the History Off the Page Victorian Day, please show the children in your group how to use them safely.

**School Room Black Board** – Falling – This is balanced on an easel. Observation only by children. Adult use only.

**Paraffin Lamp** – Lit during school room session. Observation only.

**Ink Pots** – Non hazardous. Contact on skin, wash with soap and water, contact will temporarily dye skin. Contact with eyes, wash with clear, tepid water. If swallowed, no adverse effects anticipated.

**Scissors** – all scissors are round ended, child safety scissors. To be supervised by an adult.

**Sewing Needles** – Very pointed, sharp ends. Children to be shown how to use them safely. To be supervised by an adult.

All equipment is to be used for the correct purpose stated. All other substances are non-hazardous and are safe to use. Only require cleaning/washing for cosmetic reasons.

Full COSHH assessments are held by the HOP staff. These are stored in their van.
